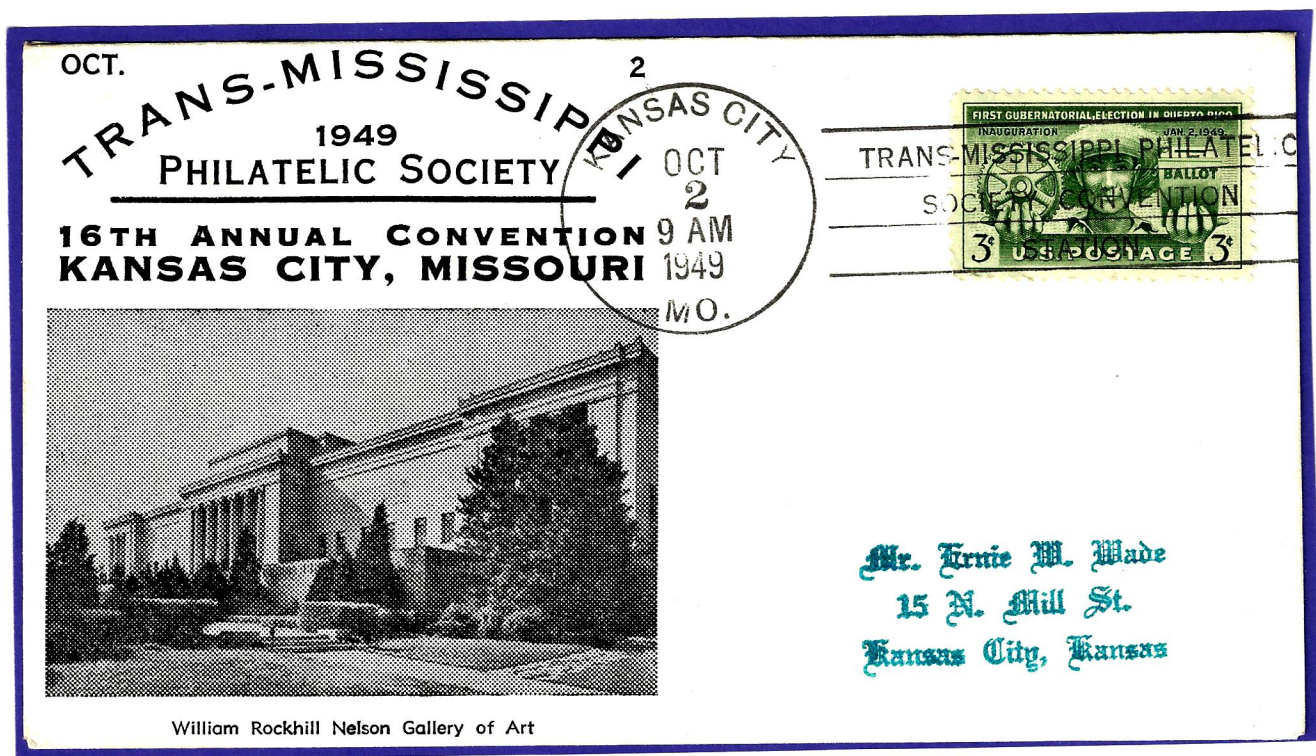

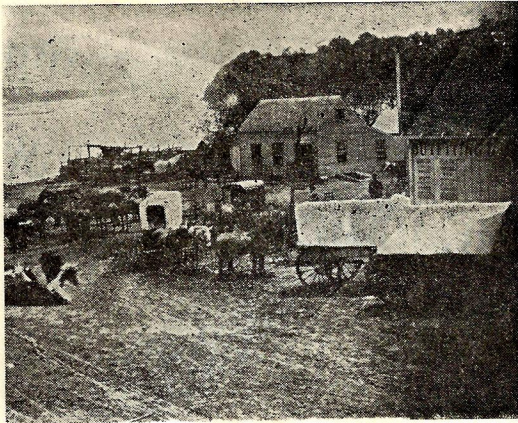

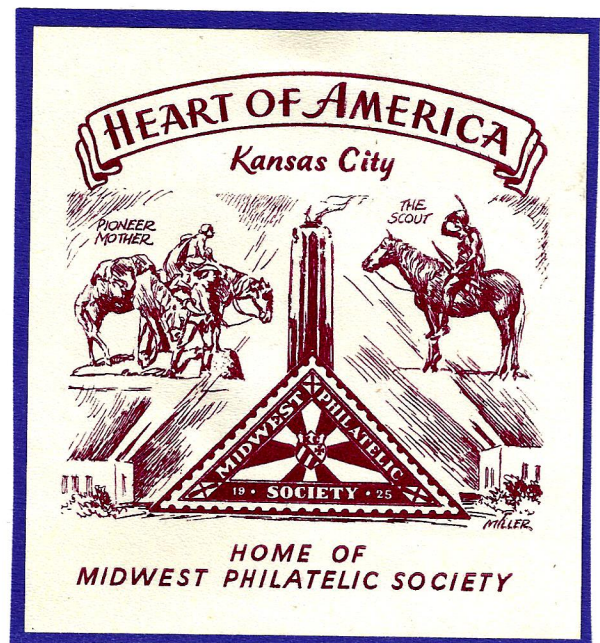
This souvenir cover was issued by the Midwest Philatelic Society to commemorate Kansas City getting its own stamp issue on the Centennial of the city in 1950.

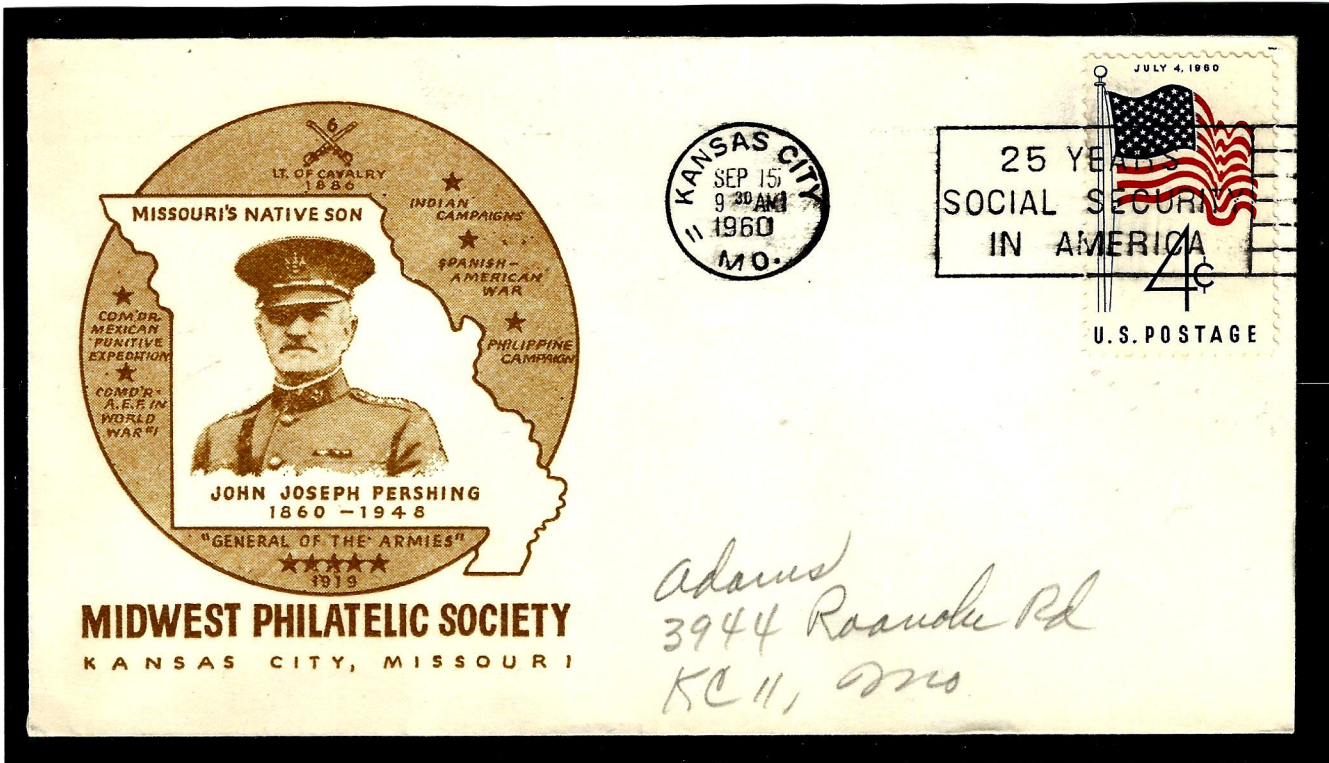
